# ХОД УРОКА

#### 1. Организационный момент

### 3. Постановка проблемы урока

На слайде представлены 3 изображения великих человека. Учитель читает информацию об одном из них и предлагает угадать, о ком сегодня будет идти речь на уроке (слайд 1).

## 4. Изучение нового материала

Детям раздается текст «Nostradamus the Prophet». Работа с текстом: чтение one by one (друг за другом по цепочке).

Первичное усвоение новых знаний: задание после текста True, false, not stated (правда, ложь, нет упоминания в тексте).

Разделение работы по группам:

Группа 1: поиск английских эквивалентов в тексте (слайд 3)

Группа 2: поиск и исправление ошибок в предложениях (слайд 4)

Совместное заполнение таблицы (Fact file): поиск в тексте запрашиваемой информации (слайд 5).

Информация о домашнем задании, инструктаж по его выполнению.

#### 6. Рефлексия

Карточка на формирование умения проводить личностную самооценку.
